## **Information to Candidates: -**

1. Schedule of Diploma selection program.

- \* *Issue of form* : 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2026
- \* *Last date for submission of filled application form* : 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2026
- \* *Date of merit list & Provisional Results* : Within 7 working days of HSLC/ HSSLC 2026 result declaration.
- \* *Issue of Nomination letter* : Within 1 week after Provisional result
- \* *Period of admission in Polytechnics* : Shall be strictly as specified in Nomination Letter.

2. Avoid overwriting.

3. Incomplete application forms shall be summarily rejected.

4. Candidates are required to submit two recent passport size photographs (3.5cm / 3cm), Admit Card and Marksheet of HSLC/HSSLC (and also Scheduled Tribe, Indigenous Inhabitant of Nagaland and Backward Tribe Certificates as applicable) - duly attested, along with their application.

5. Applicants are required to deposit Rs. 200/- (Rupees two hundred) only, (non-refundable) in cash for each form.

6. Candidates are required to submit their forms to the Office of the Directorate of Technical Education, Kohima or any of the Polytechnic Institute by hand.

7. Candidates are required to exercise their options in the preference column provided for the purpose. Mark 1,2,3,4. etc. against the diploma programmes in order of preference.

8. Not receiving of refusal / acceptance letter within stipulated time would lead to cancellation of candidature

### **Procedure of Selection: -**

1. Selection of Candidates is done on the basis of the merit from the HSLC/HSSLC marks and also incorporating reservation policies of the State.
2. Candidates are to submit their mark sheet of HSLC/HSSLC within 3 working days after the declaration of result of HSLC/HSSLC result.
3. In case of tie in the merit list a candidate be ranked higher on the basis of marks scored in Maths, Science, English of HSLC/HSSLC and age for Engineering/Architecture Assistantship/Interior Design category. In case of tie in Fashion Technology merit list a candidate will be ranked higher on the basis of marks scored in English, General Knowledge, Maths and Science of HSLC and age.
4. Selection of candidate to a Diploma Program will be done based on HSLC/HSSLC merit list and availability of seat in the Diploma Program(s) of his/her stated preference (s).
5. Naga Indigenous inhabitants of the State shall be accorded first preference for selection. Thereafter, preference shall be accorded to children of non-Naga Indigenous inhabitant of the State, children of Non-Naga State Govt. Employees, Central Govt./Agency Employees serving in the State as per merit in HSLC/HSSLC.
6. In the event of discrepancy in merit list, selection, nomination, the Selection Committee shall decide the course of action and shall recommend to authority for implementation.

### **Reservation Policy: -**

1. 15% reservation shall be made for Backward Tribes on the basis of One Tribe One Seat as per merit in the Diploma Entrance Exam.
2. 10% of the total intake in all courses shall be reserved for Female Candidate.
3. 5% special reservation shall be made for Differently able/Physically Handicapped students. The selection of students shall be made as per disability conditions prescribed by Medical Council of India/State in its notification in the regard.
4. Out of the remaining seats, 90% of seats will be reserved for ST Indigenous of Nagaland and 10% of seats will be reserved for General Category against the following Courses: **(Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering and Fashion Technology, Architecture Assistantship, Interior Design) except Civil Engineering**
5. In the event, there are no takers from the above 1) 2) 3) & 4) categories, then the seats shall be de-reserved to ST Naga candidate belonging to the State of Nagaland.
